

SPECIAL SESSION BULLITT COUNTY FISCAL COURT
HELD ON MONDAY JUNE 4, 2018, AT 3:00 P.M.

Judge Roberts called the meeting to order at 3:00 P.m. and welcomed everyone. All magistrates were present.

FISCAL COURT BUDGET 2018-2019
CHANGES

Chief Financial Officer Keith Griffey spoke to Fiscal Court about the 2018-2019 Bullitt County Fiscal Court Budget. He discussed three things that needed to be addressed such as Magistrates proposed raise of \$62,724.00 to \$80,000.00, decreasing the raise of \$1.00 back down to \$.50 for county workers, and decreasing the proposed budget of \$86,000.00 back down to \$59,000.00 for the Animal Control.

The Magistrates have not received a raise in 38 years and would like to increase the salary total to \$80,000.00 for all four Magistrates. Chief Financial Officer Keith Griffey stated that without an evaluation system it is hard to gauge raises per individual, so Fiscal Court decided to do a \$.50 raise across the board. Director Mike Howe was present to voice his concern over the raise. He stated that he did not receive a raise when he took over the Director position and believes he should get at least a \$1.00 raise at this time.


Judge Roberts stated that she does not agree with decreasing the 2018-2019 raises for county employees or reducing the Animal Shelter's staff Budget.

On motion of Esq. Mitchell, seconded by Esq. Rayhill, with Fiscal Court having concurred, to change the 2018-2019 Budget to a \$.50 raise for all county employees, except a Director position, and to keep the Animal Shelter's staff the same as last year at \$59,000.


Vote: Three (3) For Mitchell, Laswell, Rayhill; Two (2) Against Judge, Lawson—motion carried.

ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, on motion of Judge Roberts, seconded by Esq. Rayhill, and following a unanimous vote, the meeting adjourned at 3:20 p.m.
