

REGULAR SESSION BULLITT COUNTY FISCAL COURT
HELD ON TUESDAY JUNE 2, 2020, AT 9:30 A.M.

Judge Summers called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. and welcomed everyone. All magistrates were present. Chief Financial Officer Keith Griffee gave the invocation and led the pledge to the flag.

TREASURER'S TRANSFER REPORT

Transfers: Expenditures by Date from the Treasurer's Office dated through June 2, 2020 has been submitted for Fiscal Court's review and approval. Copies are on file in the County Clerk's Office.

On motion by Esq. Mitchell, seconded by Esq. Logsdon, with Fiscal Court having concurred, accepting the Transfers: Expenditures by Date Report as presented.

FISCAL COURT/TREASURER BILLS APPROVED

Open Invoice Reports from the Judge/Executive's Office dated through June 2, 2020 had been submitted for Fiscal Court's review and approval and copies are on file in the County Clerk's Office. Disbursements from each fund totaled: #01- \$292,153.47; #02- \$65,029.19; #03- \$18,712.92; #09- \$5,289.92; #77- \$94,755.41. Grand total disbursements from all funds: \$475,940.91.

Open Invoice Reports from the Treasurer's Office dated through May 21, 2020 had been submitted for Fiscal Court's review and approval and copies are on file in the County Clerk's Office. Disbursements from each fund totaled: #00- \$42,429.15; #01- \$86,361.01; #02- \$38,179.02; #03- \$77,315.78; #09- \$108,606.71. Grand total disbursements from all funds: \$352,891.67.

On motion of Esq. Rayhill, seconded by Esq. Laswell, with Fiscal Court having concurred, the claims referenced above totaling \$828,832.58 were approved as presented and were ordered to be paid.

MINUTES APPROVED

On motion of Esq. Logsdon, seconded by Esq. Mitchell, and Fiscal Court having agreed to dispense with the formal reading, the minutes of the regular session of Bullitt County Fiscal Court held on Tuesday, May 19, 2020, and the LGEA and CRA Funds Hearing held on Tuesday, May 19, 2020, were approved as presented and the Judge was authorized to sign same.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SERVICES PARAMEDIC SUPERVISORS

Discussion was had amongst the Human Resources Director Rhonda Walls, Magistrates, and Judge Summers. There is a goal of 12 Paramedics total, but if they open four new positions for Paramedic Supervisors, it would put their total to 8 Full Time Paramedics at the current time. They also want to increase pay for the Paramedics because they cannot keep them here in Bullitt County at the current rate of pay.

On motion of Judge Summers, seconded by Esq. Mitchell, with Fiscal Court having concurred, to accept four new Paramedic Supervisor positions at \$26.00 per hour and increase Paramedic pay to

\$25.00 per hour, effective July 1, 2020.

JUDICIAL CENTER
PART TIME TO FULL TIME CUSTODIAN

On motion of Judge Summers, seconded by Esq. Mitchell, with Fiscal Court having concurred, to increase Kerrylyn Holehan from Part Time Custodian to Full Time Custodian at the Bullitt County Judicial Center, effective June 4, 2020.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SERVICES
ADVANCED EMT

On motion of Judge Summers, seconded by Esq. Rayhill, with Fiscal Court having concurred, to increase pay for John Williams and Nickolas Steinfeld as Advanced EMT's to \$19.50 per hour, effective June 2, 2020.

Vote: Unanimous for—motion carried.


ANNOUNCEMENTS
