BE IT ORDAINED by the Fiscal Court of County of Bullitt, Commonwealth of Kentucky:

SUMMARY

WHEREAS, the proposed budget was tentatively approved by the Fiscal Court of Bullitt County on the 7th day of June, 2022, and approved as to form and classification by the State Local Finance Officer on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2022.


**NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY**



RESOLUTION NO. 22-07

ANNUAL STANDING ORDER TO PRE-APPROVE CERTAIN RECURRING EXPENSES

Pursuant to KRS §68.275(3) "The fiscal court may adopt an order, to pre-approve the payment of monthly payroll and utility expenses. No other expenses shall be pre-approved pursuant to this subsection without the written consent of the state local finance officer." The fiscal court of Bullitt County in accordance with state law hereby orders recurring expenses for payroll and utilities be paid when due.

The fiscal court of Bullitt County further orders upon the written consent of the state local finance officer the following expenses be paid when due:

It is hereby acknowledged the above standing orders shall expire after July 1 of each fiscal year and no more payments designated in the standing order shall be pre-approved unless a new order is adopted by the fiscal court of Bullitt County according to the provisions of KRS §68.275(3).
