Judge Summers called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. and welcomed everyone. All Magistrates were present.

ELECTION EQUIPMENT  
PURCHASE

County Clerk Kevin Mooney spoke to the Court about the need for additional Election Equipment. He stated that Electronic Pollbooks that were originally gifted from the State, will not be available in the May election. We need to purchase the county's new equipment through Knowink for \$198,000.00 that will include set up and delivery of 110 Electronic Poll Books, as well as the Verizon Wireless activation. The County also needs to purchase additional Verity Scanners and Verity Printers through a contract with HARP Enterprises for an additional \$272,174.00. The County also needs additional tables to set up with the additional locations that will be offered this year. The contract through Election Source is for 126 Select Duo Voting Booths for a total of \$32,727.80, pending additional discounts. County Clerk Kevin Mooney stated that they should be able to get reimbursements on the Electronic Poll Books at \$1700.00 per unit, at the \$1735.00 purchase price. There are additional reimbursements available for the Verity Scanners and Printers, but it is unknown the amount at this time. The Counties throughout the State are trying to stabilize and adjust to the use of Vote Centers, and establish what equipment is needed to cover voter turnout.


