**MARK12 MINISTRIES**

Perry Cooke, of Mark12 Ministries, gave an update to the Court. He stated that they had opened the white flag shelter at the First Baptist Church of Shepherdsville due to frigid temperatures, as well as warming stations at Mercy Hill Baptist Church. He stated that in 2024. They have helped 1,061 individuals and gave \$66,700 in assistance through the Outreach Thrift Store. They offer six different support groups, 20 facilitators, Veteran Support Groups, and USA Cares Partnership to hopefully obtain some federal funding. They have donated four vehicles to families in need, and have 17 participants through Room in the Inn.

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**PRESENTATION**  
**EXTENSION AGENCY HOMEMAKERS**

Ruth Chowning, of the Bullitt County Extension Office, presented some information to the Court. She stated that the Homemakers are dedicated to Education and for providing services to the community. The Homemakers presented a check to the Court in the amount of \$825,062.90 to represent the amount of hours this organization worked and assistance to the community. The Court thanked them for their services in Bullitt County.



Magistrate Sanders thanked the Homemakers for coming today and all their services to Bullitt County.


