

REGULAR SESSION BULLITT COUNTY FISCAL COURT
HELD ON TUESDAY, AUGUST 19, 2025, AT 9:30 A.M.

Judge Summers called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. and welcomed everyone. All Magistrates were present. Perry Cooke, from Mark12 Ministries, gave the invocation and led the pledge to the flag.

MINUTES APPROVED

On motion of Esq. Bleemel, seconded by Esq. Johnson, and Fiscal Court having agreed to dispense with the formal reading, the minutes of the regular session of Bullitt County Fiscal Court held on Tuesday, August 5, 2025 were approved as presented and the Judge was authorized to sign same.

TREASURER'S TRANSFER REPORT

Transfers: Expenditures by Date from the Treasurer's Office dated through August 19, 2025 has been submitted for Fiscal Court's review and approval. Copies are on file in the County Clerk's Office.

FISCAL COURT BILLS APPROVED

Open Invoice Reports from the Judge/Executive's Office dated through August 19, 2025 had been submitted for Fiscal Court's review and approval and copies are on file in the County Clerk's Office. Disbursements from each fund totaled: #01- \$398,384.23; #02- \$40,846.83; #03- \$70,245.08; #09- \$101,061.33; #77- \$151,045.66. Grand total disbursements from all funds: \$761,583.13.

Discussion was had amongst members of the Court on payment to Carla Johnson as a contract laborer for Emergency Medical Services.

On motion of Judge Summers, seconded by Esq. Logsdon, with Fiscal Court having concurred, the claims referenced above totaling \$761,583.13 were approved as presented and were ordered to be paid.

SPEAKER
SHERIFF'S OFFICE FOUNDATION

CHAMBER OF COMMERCE

Director Anita Stump invited the Court to the next events coming up in the County. She also wanted to remind the Court that the September Luncheon will be a little different and they will be delivering food to the First Responders throughout the County.

SPEAKER
BERNHEIM MIDDLE SCHOOL

Randy Scott expressed his concerns over the traffic in the Bernheim Forest area. Traffic in the morning and school release is a danger to the children on buses and families taking and picking up their children. He is asking for the County to look into having an Officer aid in directing traffic in the mornings and afternoons around school time. He would also like to see the speed limit reduced in that area. Judge Summers stated that they will look into different agencies and see who could help with traffic control near Bernheim Middle School. He also stated that the road is being widened to four lanes, and that should perhaps alleviate some congestion.

PRESENTATION
FEMA REIMBURSEMENT

Assistant Director Waters, of Emergency Management Services, gave a brief FEMA reimbursement update. He stated that from the February disaster the County should be getting reimbursed approximately \$50,000 for debris removal, \$216,000 for emergency protective measures, and \$50,000

for roads and bridges work. All roadwork should be completed by the first week of September.

ROAD LISTING
RILEY RIDGE

On motion of Esq. Sanders, seconded by Esq. Bleemel, with Fiscal Court having concurred, to add Riley Ridge into the official Bullitt County Road Listing as a private road.

CODE ENFORCEMENT

On motion of Esq. Logsdon, seconded by Esq. Sanders, with Fiscal Court having concurred, to approve the Bullitt County Code Enforcement's Fee Schedule.

On motion of Judge Summer, seconded by Esq. Logsdon, with Fiscal Court having concurred, to adopt the Radio Reception Ordinance and to direct the County Attorney to draft the Radio Reception Ordinance and have the first reading at the next Fiscal Court meeting on September 2, 2025.

Vote: Unanimous for—motion carried.


ANNOUNCEMENTS


