

ZONING ORDINANCE: SECOND READING
ORDINANCE #25-31

An ordinance proposed by the City of Shepherdsville, was given second reading and public hearing at this meeting held on December 16, 2025.

- Ordinance #25-31; Docket #2025T-03; An Ordinance proposing to amend Bullitt County Planning and Zoning Regulations to allow temporary transitional housing.

NO ACTION TAKEN AT THIS TIME SINCE THIS IS GOVERNED BY FEDERAL LAW.

SHERIFF'S OFFICE
2026 BUDGET

Sheriff Sholar presented the 2026 Sheriff's Office Budget to the Court for approval. Discussion was had regarding the significant increase of 1.37 million more than last year. Sheriff Sholar stated that they are looking at 10% pay increases for Road Deputies, Detectives, SRO, and Dare Officer, and a 5% increase for Office Administration Staff and Courthouse Deputies. They must stay competitive with their pay scale because surrounding areas with higher pay are consistently taking their deputies. He also stated that after the Statewide Security Team looked over the Courthouse, they need an additional eight Deputies at the courthouse to manage security properly. These items have increased the budget significantly since last year, but one that is necessary. Chief Financial Officer Keith Griffiee stated that they have \$623,00.00 in a separate line item for raises. That will decrease the overall budget increase, along with other fees and moneys, to leave an increase of around \$200,000.00 in the budget from last year to the current 2026 budget. Magistrate Bleemel asked if the Sheriff's Office supplies their employees with BluMine, and they do not. 




