HELD ON TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 3, 2026, AT 9:30 A.M.

Judge Summers called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. and welcomed everyone. All Magistrates were present. Chief Financial Officer, Keith Griffee, gave the invocation and led the pledge to the flag.

MINUTES APPROVED

On motion of Esq. Logsdon, seconded by Esq. Bleemel, and Fiscal Court having agreed to dispense with the formal reading, the minutes of the regular session of Bullitt County Fiscal Court held on Tuesday, January 20, 2026, were approved as presented and the Judge was authorized to sign same.

TREASURER'S TRANSFER REPORT

On motion of Esq. Johnson, seconded by Esq. Bleemel, with Fiscal Court having concurred, the claims referenced above totaling \$581,745.50 were approved as presented and were ordered to be paid.

Crystal Obrien, with Bikes with Wings Inc., spoke to Court about updating the skate park in Mt

Washington. Bikes with Wings, along with the City of Mt Washington, want to expand the skate park at Lindsey Duvall Park with a PLG Pumptrack. The total project cost would be \$200,000 and the City of Mt Washington has committed to \$100,000.00 and Bike with Wings has committed to \$50,000.00. They are asking the County to invest \$50,000.00 into this expansion project. Discussion was had amongst members of the Court and suggestions were made to include the newly formed Bullitt County Sports and Recreation Board.

EMERGENCY SERVICES UPDATE

Director Warren and Director Waters gave a brief update from the recent winter weather event. They planned accordingly and offered several warming stations throughout the county, with the help of different organizations. Some were utilized and some were not, but were critical for precautionary measures. Director Warren says that EMS was fully operational and had over 75 runs within that period. They maneuvered the ambulances throughout the county for the winter weather and brought on three additional fly cars. Emergency Management assisted homeowners with emergency supplies and were available for the community. Members of the Court thanked them for their hard work and preparation for this winter storm. They thanked all the County Departments for working together and working around the clock for our community. Magistrate Logsdon asked homeowners to investigate to see if their road is a private road or county-maintained road to properly prepare for future events.



Magistrate Sander thanked all the county workers for working hard in this weather.


